Sealed bids are solicited for a 1 mile paved road in South Bee County, Baker RD. To start on August 30, 2021.

Bid responses received after the closing time and date will be returned to the sender unopened. Facsimile (FAX) and electronic (EMAIL) bids are not accepted by Bee County.

Instructions to Bidder

The County reserves the right to withdraw the request for the bids for any reason or to reject any or all bids. The County further reserves the right to accept part or all of any specific bid or bids.

Bids cannot be altered or amended once received by Bee County.

The County is exempt from Federal Excise and State Sales Tax; therefore, tax must not be Included in the bid price.

All prices quoted by the bidder will remain firm for a minimum of 90 days from the date of the bid unless otherwise specified by the county or bidder.

All products offered shall be bid F.O.B final destination as noted elsewhere in the request, with all the delivery charges to be prepaid by the bidder. Bidder shall specify date of delivery.

Guarantees and warranties should be attached as a part of the bid as they may be a consideration in awarding the contract.

The successful bidder's rights and duties awarded by the contract may not be assigned to another without written consent of the County's signed by the county's authorized agent. Such consent shall not relieve the assigner of the liability in the event of the default by the assignee.

Should there be a decline in the market price of the commodities provided during this contract, the County shall have the benefit of such decline.

The bid shall be based on, but not necessarily limited to:

- a) Unit price
- b) Total price
- c) Delivery price
- d) Quality and length of warranty
- e) Special needs and requirements of Bee County
- f) Bee County's experience with products bid
- g) Vendor's past performance record with Bee County
- h) Bee County's evaluation of Vendor's ability

The County reserves the right to hold all bids for thirty (30) days before final decision and ordering is made for this purchase.

Any ambiguity in the bid as a result of omission, error, lack of clarity or noncompliance by the bidder with specifications, instructions and all conditions of bidding shall be construed in the favor of the County.

The County reserves the right to terminate the contract upon ten (10) days written notice if the vendor fails to perform in a manner deemed acceptable to the County. If the County chooses to terminate the contract, or if the bidder cannot supply the product, the second lowest bidder may be given the opportunity to complete the contract.

No oral statement of any person shall modify or otherwise change, or affect the terms, conditions or specifications stated in the resulting contract. All the change orders to the contract will be made in writing and shall not be effective unless signed by an authorized representative of the County.

The County may, by written notice to the successful bidder, cancel this contract without liability to the bidder if it is determined by the County that gratuities or bribes in the form of entertainment, gifts, or otherwise, were offered or given by the successful bidder, or its agent or representative to any County official, employee or elected representative with respect to the performance of the contract. In addition, the successful bidder may be subject to penalties stated in Title 8 of the Texas Penal Code.

All insurance requirements, including Workmen's Compensation, as outlined in Texas State Statutes shall be met and proof of same be provided to the Bee County Auditor's office before commencing services. Bee County shall be listed as an additional insured throughout the duration of the contract. Payments shall not become due and payable until such certificates have been filed.

To rebuild one (1) mile of Baker Road

SPECIFICATIONS:

- 1.) Existing road would be scarified
- 2.) Twenty (20) feet wide
- 3.) Five (5) inch caliche base
- 4.) Two (2) course grade rock #3 and #4 (county will provide)
- 5.) AC5 oil, both coarses will be shot at Rate .30
- 6.) Pavement will be 18ft wide
- 7.) All material must meet TXDOT specifications
