I am interested in becoming a Poll Worker in Bee County. I understand that by filling in this form and submitting it, my name and contact information will be placed in the database of interested Election Workers. I understand that working as a Poll Worker in Bee County the rate of pay is between \$12.00 per hour and \$14.00 per hour and required taxes will be withheld. I understand I will receive a 1099 form at the end of any year I work.

This information will also be sent to the party I indicated affiliation with (if applicable) for placement in any of the Primary Elections. If I indicate no affiliation my name will be sent to both party chairs.

Important Note: In order to serve as an election worker, you must be a registered voter in Bee County.

Job Requirements:

Must be 18 years of age or older; High school students must be 16 and have parental permission

Do not hold an elected office or are not the employee of an elected official

Not an immediate family member of an elected official on the ballot

Must be detail-oriented; able to take directions well and follow instructions

Not be easily distracted

Able to interact with public and have the ability to answer questions

Have dependable transportation to and from the polling places

Ability to lift at least 30 lbs.; sit or stand for extended periods of time

May be required to work 12-14 hours on Election Day or During Early Voting

- Early Voting Clerk: works in Main Early Voting location to check in voters or assist voters in voting
- Central Count Station: assist with checking in Polling Places; processing equipment return and other tasks
- Early Ballot Board: processes Ballot by Mail ballots; collaborates with team members to qualify ballots
